Methodology

Family Enrichment courses are based on the case study method used in many law and business school programs. While the case studies are a means of discussion, it is the shared wisdom of, and the experience of the participating couples, crystallized in the general session by a trained moderator, who is also a married parent, that brings its value.

Couples analyze together cases presenting real-life family situations; they discuss these cases with a small group of couples, and then everyone participates in a moderated general session. The method allows couples to address common problems in family life and benefit from the insights of others. The course allows participants to meet like-minded couples and thereby build communities of support and friendship.



Objectives

ONE

Educate spouses regarding the human virtues that enhance their marriage and their role as the primary educators of their children.

TWO

Learn to identify opportunities, solve issues and set goals within the family through the "Case Study" method - an interactive technique for analyzing real life family situations in an objective, practical and positive way.

THREE

Improve communications between spouses, helping them differentiate important issues from secondary matters.

FOUR

Make informed decisions by thinking in terms of the long-range outcome of their parenting.

FIVE

Meet and form friendships by learning with other couples who are committed to improving their marriage and family life.
